LOCATION:

Casablanca Valley is 80 km. coast direction from Santiago.

Our vineyards are located near Casablanca city, in the mountain slopes, bringing together the Coastal Range and the Pacific Ocean.

CLIMATE:

Being a semi-arid climate valley, the proximity of the Pacific Ocean delivers a strong maritime influence, with morning fogs and considerable temperature variability between day and night, fostering a slow grape ripening and driving the subsequent concentration of aromas and favours.

SOIL:

Mostly clay with sand making up low fertility soils.

PLANTED VARIETIES:

Mainly Pinot Noir, Sauvignon Blanc and Chardonnay.

WINE CHARACTERISTICS:

Algarrobo Vineyard gives exceptional expressions of freshness and fruit.
